Your child's day will begin in our Gross Motor area where they will have a chance to socialize with their peers as well as get some energy out before entering the classroom.

We will transition from our Gross Motor area to the classroom environment where your child will begin their two-hour uninterrupted work cycle, in a peacefully and supportive environment that is designed to promote your child's growth in all areas of development. During this time, your child will also have the opportunity to help prepare, serve, eat, and clean up a nutritious snack. They will be given the opportunity to participate in art activities that are designed specifically for their level of completion and development.

In addition to nurturing your child's growing independence throughout the classroom, our self-care area provides them the opportunity in toilet awareness.

Following the work cycle, we will head outside rain or shine, temperature permitting, so be sure to send your child to school with appropriate clothing for the days forecast.

Coming in from outside we will gather for books, songs, fingerplays, health lessons and other activities such as the occasional science experiment, all geared at encouraging the children to interact with one another building upon their communication skills. Dismissal or lunch will follow.

After a prepared lunch from home, children will be provided with an individual floor mat for napping in our designated sleeping area.

When your child wakes from nap they will gather their belongings for dismissal or join our Specialist in Afterschool Care.
