



Dear Toddler Families,

On behalf of the staff at Adeline Montessori School, we are happy to welcome you to the 2026-2027 school year! We are looking forward to an exciting year, ensuring your child can achieve their highest potential in the Toddler Program. We know that a strong partnership with you will make a great difference in your child's education. As partners, we share responsibilities for your children's success. We ask that you support your child's learning by ensuring that he/she:

- Attend's school on their scheduled day
- Arrives on time
- Comes prepared for the day

### **Drop-off**

For families arriving before 7:45, drop-off will be in Toddler 1 (Room 104). Anyone that arrives after 7:45 will go straight to the classroom. We ask that you leave good-byes "quick and confident" at the door, this makes for an easier transition to your child's day.

### **Cubbies**

All extra clothes will be in a bag located at your child's hook and should be labeled with your child's name or initials. Any wet or soiled clothes will be sent back home in your provided wet bag with your child to be washed. Please be sure to replenish. Any toys from home must be left at your child's cubby as they present a distraction to the work that we do in the classroom.

### **Snack**

Snack is prepared by the children throughout their work cycle and enjoyed in a family style setting. Each child will have an opportunity to be Chef of the Week. They will provide nutritious snack options for an entire week and share these options with their friends.

### **Lunch**

If your child is attending lunch, please prepare a nutritious meal in a way that your child can eat with independence. Foods should be cut to sizes that your child can eat independently. Anything that is round (i.e., cherry tomatoes and grapes) needs to be quartered for safety reasons. Warm items should be sent in a thermos as we cannot warm food in the microwave. We provide water as a beverage option during lunch. You are welcome to send other beverages in their lunch box that will be given to them during this time. Any food or drink that is not consumed by your child during lunch will be sent home.

**Nap**

If your child attends naptime, you are welcome to send a comfort item that does not produce sound or light and an optional blanket. For naptime we provide a mat, blanket, and a soothing environment in which to rest.

**Pick-Up**

Daily pick-up for half day families is at 12:00 p.m. and for full day families at 3:00 p.m. This will be hosted in the lobby where you may walk in to retrieve your child. This would be an appropriate time to communicate with staff about your child's day.

Please be sure that you are picking up your infant first. We cannot allow older children in the infant classroom at this time, as other infants might be sleeping, and it is unsafe for children to be in the hallway unsupervised.

**After-Care Program**

After-school care is from 3 to 5 p.m. During that time, your child will have a single serve school provided snack consisting of fruits or veggies and a grain. It is with an abundance of caution that we do not allow snacks from home during this time due to allergies.

**Birthday Celebrations**

Children's birthdays are celebrated with a special ceremony in the Montessori classroom. We encourage students to bring in a favorite book to share. In consideration of nutrition, allergies, and unique family needs, we will not be allowing food as a birthday treat. Students are welcome to bring in non-food items such as pencils, fidgets, small toys, etc.

# Adeline Toddler Supply List

Please bring the following items to be left and used at school.

- Extra Clothes:
  - 3 pairs of pants
  - 3 shirts
  - 2 pairs of socks
  - 1 pair of shoes
  - 3 pairs of underwear (toilet trained/training children)
- Season appropriate outdoor clothes (rain/winter boots, raincoat, snow pants, hat, gloves)
- 1 wet bag for your child's soiled clothes
- 1 package of pull-ups/diapers
- 1 package wipes
- Rash cream/ointment
- Sunscreen/bug spray (seasonal)
- 1 box of gallon size plastic bags
- 1 box of sandwich size plastic bags
- 1 boxes of tissue
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes
- Favorite art supply (i.e. stickers, watercolors, dotters, paint sticks, collage items)
- 1 unframed 4x6 family photo, pets too!
- 1 houseplant / succulent
- 1 nap time friend - optional (for children that stay after 12:00 am)
- Water bottle
- Classroom shoes

Items left at school need to be labeled with your child's name or initials.

All rash creams/ointments, sunscreens, and bug sprays to be applied at school require a completed authorization form.
